LOVE LOCKET rated off the pace toward mid track, started her drive approaching the quarter pole, was alongside the pacesetter at the seventy yard pole and edging away the closing yards. ZOOMING BY, firmly held to set the pace inside, was pressured losing some ground leaving the final turn, drifted inward from the eighth pole and yielded later yards. JULIE B showed no speed outside, bid approaching the quarter pole and finished evenly. FOR KISSES, unhurried early, bid on the rail into the final turn, came slightly out for the drive and finished evenly. SUMMER ROMANCE rated off the pace inside, gave chase approaching the final turn then weakened on the rail through the lane. PRETTY PROUD showed no speed outside. ROYAL FUPEG kept close to the early pace just off the rail then no further response through the final turn. SARATOGA DRIVE showed no speed outside, appeared dull and was eased into the stretch.
