JOANN JR showed the way to the lane while off the rail, responded to pressure and drew out late. MONTSMOKE advanced in the two path turning for home, continued to gain along the inside to loom a solid threat a furlong out then could not keep pace with the top one. STANDSWITHAFIST chased early from the outside and lacked the needed stretch response. MY TRUE IDENTITY chased early and tired in the drive. RAVISHLY saved ground while an early factor and weakened. GRAND PIANO bumped lightly at the start, was eased nearing the turn then walked off.
