SILVER MOOSE raced in the three path into the lane and closed strongly while prevailing at the wire. YES YES YES four deep early, raced three deep into the turn, battled for command outside of DIAMOND WILDCAT into the lane, drew clear late then just missed. SWISSLE STICK stumbled at the start, raced just off the inside turning for home and finished willingly. DIAMOND WILDCAT between foes early, vied for the lead and saved ground on the turn then weakened in the drive. PINCH THE CLOWN in a bit close at the start, pressed the early issue between rivals and tired in the drive. CONCORDE'S EDGE broke a bit slowly and inside early, dropped back into the turn, raced four wide into the lane and weakened. WHAT'S UP DUDE lacked a rally. ON TO BOSTON broke out, raced outside on the turn and lacked a response.
