PARK AVENUE BALL advanced to the lead three wide into the first turn, moved clear toward the inside entering the backstretch to rate the pace, was pressured away into the stretch then widened slightly with steady encouragement. INDY WIND broke outward then drifted in early, rated just off the pace about the three path, moved to threaten the winner three wide approaching the quarter pole, proved no match for that one then just lasted for place. SMOKESCREEN settled off the pace inside after being jostled leaving the gate, eased four wide making his bid into the stretch, was gaining steadily and just missed place. HALOS SAILING SAIN was shuffled back on the first turn, advanced to contention near the rail through the backstretch, lacked the speed to take advantage of an opening entering the stretch and finished evenly. ITSAWONDERFULIFE was brushed at the start, showed no speed while saving ground, came out entering the stretch and had no rally. FREEDOM ISNT FREE was outrun. SKYCROSSING was pinched back from early contention, settled in off the pace about the three path then had no stretch response.
