RACHEL ALEXANDRA was well placed in the two path stalking the leader, moved up alongside to challenge entering the turn, put a head in front turning for home, responded when asked, edged clear and pulled away late under energetic handling. QUEEN MARTHA set the pace along the inside, dug in gamely on the far turn, battled in upper stretch and came up second best. ASK THE MOON raced off the pace, advanced inside on the far turn and rallied mildly. STAGE TRICK raced close up inside and failed to respond when asked. HARK was off slowly, outrun early and passed tired foes. YES SHE'S A LADY raced three wide early, stalked outside and tired. FABULOUS BABE pulled on the first turn, chased and gave way.
