TRIAL FIGHTER bobbled slightly at the start, stalked the lead firmly in hand just outside the pacesetter, moved to the front when ready entering the stretch then drew off responding well to pressure. DECLINED AMX raced unhurriedly while never far back and just off the rail, was eased out entering the stretch and rallied for place. DANDY DULCE rated close to the pace three wide, made a mild bid entering the stretch then languished late. SAINTTWOK, off the pace five wide, was carried slightly outward entering the stretch then tired. GIGI'S MAGIC rated the pace on the inside, was a factor entering the stretch then showed no response from the eighth pole and was not abused. MINT REPORT gave way after the opening half mile.
