QUICK ACTION vied for the lead to the lane and finished well while edging clear. LITTLE RED ROCKET advanced outside on the turn and finished willingly. WAR'S PROSPECT stumbled at the start and bumped, advanced five deep nearing the top of the lane then lacked the needed late response. DANDOON raced six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. NEXT BANDIT vied for the early lead between foes and weakened in the drive. MEDICINE EYES lacked a solid response. GENERAL TOMMY saved ground into the turn, moved out nearing the stretch and lacked a solid bid. CLIFDEN (IRE) vied early, saved ground and weakened through the lane. THE HERC broke out bumping with a rival, raced four deep on the turn and tired. MOVE TO STRIKE three deep and between rivals turning for home, weakened.
