DECEITFUL DARLING posted the early fractions then drew off through the stretch while being ridden out. OLIVIA JO advanced inside on the final turn, raced outside into the lane and finished steadily while clear for the place. PRIVY close up early while along the inside, eased out some on the last turn and weakened in the drive. SOUTHERN VOICE towards the inside into the far turn, raced off the rail turning for home and flattened out in the drive. LOST TIME saved ground and lacked a rally. GOLD BULLION five wide into the clubhouse turn, advanced to the backstretch then gave way rounding the final turn. RESPECTABLE GAL well placed early while outside, gave way on the last turn.
