### Footnotes

CITY FIRE rated on the early lead, showed the way to the lane and drew off while under mild hand urging in the late stages. TIGRESS BYTHETAIL bobbled at the break to be away awkwardly, lodged a bid between foes soon after entering the far turn, chased the top one to the lane then remained clear for the place. CHARLESTON SPRINGS stalked early from the outside, remained a factor to the lane and tired. TYNE broke a bit slowly, raced well placed to the far turn and tired. RUBYWOOD close up early while saving ground, gave way on the final turn. SHE IS RAGING rank early, went wide into the clubhouse turn, continued wide and was pulled up then returned afterwards to be unsaddled and walked off.
