SCHOLASTIC GIANT rated a short lead inside, was pressed clear into the stretch and finished well under a steady drive. CROESUS was shuffled back leaving the chute, settled unhurried outside, bid widest nearing the quarter pole and finished strong for a clear place. DAYLIGHT DANCER saved ground the opening turn, eased out while off the pace through the backstretch, started her drive four wide near the quarter pole then dueled to show. JELLYBERRY rated off the pace outside, advanced three wide through the final turn then leveled off through the lane. JIVE was crowded leaving the chute, settled in mid track unhurriedly through the backstretch, took aim into the final turn then weakened in the stretch. FROZEN TREAT was outrun. CHABLIS came through the opening turn four wide, settled in just off the rail on the backstretch and faded on the final turn. GLADIATOR GIRL saved ground the opening half, steadied on the heels of Chablis nearing the final turn and faded afterward.
