INDY WIND pressed the early issue from along the inside, moved to the front nearing the far turn, showed the way to the lane and edged away when asked then maintained a safe margin. TOUCHED BY MADNESS bobbed at the start and well placed between rivals, raced three wide turning for home and earned the place. TOO MANY TOYZ set the early pace just off the inside and weakened in the drive. TAP DAY just a bit fractious briefly in the gate, saved ground and lacked the needed response. SLEEK JOHN close up early three wide, raced outside into the lane and weakened. PIETY trailed early while not far back, was asked on the final turn and lacked the needed stretch response.
