Footnotes

IMMORTAL EYES bumped early then brushed with a rival, set the pace inside, was off the rail into the stretch and edged away then held to the wire. JAVERRE bid three wide on the turn, was in the four path into the stretch and finished gamely. HE CAN RUN broke alertly then came over early bumping with IMMORTAL EYES pressed then was brushed by that one, chased on the turn and stayed on through the stretch run while not good enough. HARBOR BREEZE never far back and five wide into the lane, lacked the needed rally. WELL SPELLED trailed and in the five path into the stretch, offered a late gain outside. M P JOE raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed bid. HOP SKIP AND AWAY saved ground and lacked a bid then tired through the lane.
