**Footnotes**

GENTLE JOURNEY vied for the lead, raced in the four path into the lane, drifted out under left handed pressure passing the furlong marker, came out again late and bumped a rival then narrowly prevailed. CALIFORNIA COOL five wide into the stretch and pushed out some passing the eighth pole, battled then just missed while being bumped late. WHISKEYONTHEROCKS raced in the three path turning for home and earned the show. LING LING QI broke a bit slowly, raced near the rail on the turn then offered stretch gain along the inside. DAZZLIN DR COLOGNE between rivals into the turn, raced just off the inside to lane, held a narrow advantage a furlong out then was not good enough. EX PAT vied early, did not keep pace on the turn, moved six wide into the stretch then gained some late. HAITIAN SENSATION vied early, raced five wide into the lane and weakened. BIG TEXAS DADDY saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. ONE NEAT CAT chased inside and tired in the drive. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of CALIFORNIA COOL against GENTLE JOURNEY for interference in the stretch, the latter was disqualified and placed second.
