MORALITY tracked early three wide, moved closer on the turn and was rated into the lane while head and head for the lead, drifted in some under right handed pressure passing the sixteenth pole, drew clear and was taken in hand nearing the wire. BWANA MOJA vied for the lead, raced along the inside into the stretch and battled the top one then was no match late while holding the place. MISSILE MOTOR never far back and three wide, finished gamely. MAX'S FIRST outside into the turn, raced in the three path into the lane and lacked a solid bid. EAGLE STRIKE saved ground and chased then lacked the needed stretch response. COOL AS EVER bobbled leaving the gate, trailed and saved ground then lacked a rally. SHOWMANSHIP broke slowly, was rushed up along the inside and vied for the lead into the turn then tired through the lane. CORCHO between rivals early, raced near the rail on the turn and tired.
