PEGGY JOYCE advanced three wide on the turn and reached the front nearing the quarter pole, drew clear in the lane then held a rival safe through the late stages. CAL DELA CASA broke just a bit slowly, raced in the three path turning for home and finished gamely. EAST SIDE CHARLEY vied through the opening stages inside then moved off the rail approaching the turn, came again and battled on the turn then weakened in the drive. HEIR STREAM broke just a bit slowly, raced just off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed bid. READY SIGNAL broke slowly, moved up to the turn, raced four wide to the lane and chased then tired in the drive. MISSREDHEAD just a bit reluctant briefly loading, broke alertly, gradually gave ground through the opening furlong, was inside on the turn and lacked a bid. MARQUET HEIRESS drew clear nearing the turn, saved ground and weakened into the lane then was not urged late .
