DEVELOPING STORY well placed early, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, reached the front turning for home, battled through the lane and edged clear nearing the wire. DOUBLE DESERT never far back while near the inside, advanced along the rail turning for home and battled with the top one then could not match strides nearing the wire. PAULSBOURBONBABY advanced on the final turn, raced in the three path into the stretch and finished willingly while needing more. THEDAMAGEISDONE saved ground into the far turn, moved out and raced five wide into the stretch then finished well. BILLYSINGSSINATRA well placed early, saved ground and chased on the final turn then lacked the needed late response. SPLENDORED THING three wide leaving the backstretch, chased and moved out off heels into the lane then lacked a stretch response. PRECIOUS PAULA set the pace and weakened in the drive. VANDALAYINDUSTRIES prompted the early issue and weakened nearing the lane. HANDFULOFDIAMONDS dropped well back in the run down the backstretch and lacked a rally.
