E MAIL PAT, unhurried early toward the outside, started her drive saving some ground on the final turn, eased out into the lane continuing that momentum to reach the lead nearing the sixteenth pole then edged clear from there. FRANSCAT rated back about the three path, advanced through the final turn, was boxed in the upper stretch, got through between horses at the sixteenth pole and finished well to place. SEA MISTRESS raced unhurried early after angling over toward the rail, closed through the backstretch, was blocked on the final turn, lacked room on the rail through the stretch and finished evenly when clear. SILKY SUMMER rated with the pace inside, contested the rail on the final turn, remained a factor to deep stretch but yielded ground late. RISQUE CENTERFOLD rated with the pace three deep, dueled to remain a close factor to midstretch then leveled off from there. FIRST INTERVIEW rated with the pace two deep, dueled between horses on the final turn then weakened the last eighth. EDISON LANES was roughed when in tight early, rated off the pace toward mid track, came six wide into the lane and leveled off. THONG rated off the pace and off the rail, was boxed in on the final turn then lacked room through the upper stretch. REMEMBERIN ELEANOR was unhurried angling out early then had no rally. TAKEITEASYEDYE never factored.
