Footnotes

CUBA alternated for the lead, raced between rivals turning for home and finished gamely while prevailing at the wire. BLANK CHECK saved ground and vied for command, responded when asked in earnest and drew clear passing the furlong marker then just failed to stay. POUND FOOLISH well placed while near the rail, finished willingly while needing more late. PERFECT FOOTPRINT between rivals on the clubhouse turn then close up outside, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, chased and needed more late. REFLECT TIMES (JPN) never far back and three wide on the clubhouse turn, raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed response. CURRAGH (ARG) trailed early while not far back, saved ground into the far turn and lacked a response then was eased up late.
