SEVENTY NINER prompted early, split rivals passing the quarter pole and drew clear in the stretch then gradually edged away, a driving winner. MACHO MO MON prompted the early issue., moved to the front on the turn and continued on willingly while second best. SILENT APPEAL up close outside, lodged a four wide bid on the turn then was not good enough while holding the show. IRISH WINDSONG lodged a bid near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed late response. TIGERWAY trailed and four wide turning for home, gained some late. STRAIGHT ARROW dropped back leaving the gate, raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed bid. KINGDOM OF DAYS saved ground and vied for the lead then tired in the drive. TAPERRIFIC near the rail on the turn, was along the inside through the lane and lacked a rally. KINGDA KA chased early inside and weakened on the turn.
