ROMACACA stalked the leader, moved up to challenge entering the far turn, took over, drew clear and held well. RAVI'S SONG raced off the pace while saving ground, moved up on the far turn, went around a tiring rival and finished willingly on the rail. PERFECT SHIRL raced off the pace inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished well outside. NO EXPLAINING (IRE) had a ground saving trip, raced between rivals into the stretch and finished well between horses for a share. CHEROKEE QUEEN stalked in the two path, bid three wide on the far turn and weakened. CHRISTINE DAAE chased and tired. UNBRIDLED ESSENCE was bumped at the start, raced off the pace, between rivals on the far turn and lacked a rally. DREAM LOUISE was bumped at the start and outrun. MARQUET MADNESS set the pace and gave way. C. S. SILK was bumped at the start, raced off the rail, gave way and was eased up late.
