MAGICAL FEELING trailed early and in the three path turning for home, advanced between rivals late and finished gamely to prevail. BRONX CITY GIRL up close early, moved closer outside foes turning for home and raced four wide into the lane, reached the front and battled gamely then just missed. LOVE THAT DANCE eased out some on the backstretch and tracked, challenged for the lead on the turn and raced between rivals into the lane, battled then yielded late. HOUR GLASS between foes into the turn, raced three wide into the lane and chased then needed more in the drive. FEEL THAT FIRE set the pace and raced just off the rail into the stretch then weakened late. INDIAN LEGEND lodged a bid outside on the turn, raced five wide into the lane and lacked a stretch response. KARMAGEDDON saved ground and lacked a bid. D'WILD RIDE chased, stayed inside and tired in the drive.
