Footnotes

BRENNAN D stalked the pace from the outside, took the lead nearing the quarter pole then dueled gamely through the stretch and held on. T. V. SECRETARY pressured the pace from between horses, remained the main threat to the winner through the stretch, was letting go late but managed to keep place. RUMBA JAZZ was boxed in steadying near the half mile pole, came five wide through the turn, rallied from the top of the stretch and was gaining slowly late. ROCK'N METALLIKA was rated close near the rail, lost momentum lacking room through the turn then went six wide nearing the quarter pole and ran evenly through the stretch. FACE THE NATION raced just off the pace widest, made an outside bid on the turn and was empty in the stretch. THE CATS COMIN pressured the pace from between horses, dropped back leaving the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. STARSHIP SUPERGIRL stalked the early pace then tired entering the turn. VOW DAHLIA advanced inside to contest the early pace then weakened while saving ground.
