FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By invitation only, with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The winning owner to receive \$700,000, \$250,000 to second, \$125,000 to third, \$85,000 to fourth, \$50,000 to fifth and \$20,000 from sixth thru last. Weight: 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a triple crown race allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I Stake at a mile or over in 2009, 4 lbs. A bonus of \$25,000 per race will be given to both the owner and trainer of any horse that has won a leg of the Triple Crown and starts in the Haskell. The owner and trainer of the winner to receive a trophy. Monmouth Park and the Graded Stakes Committee require steroid testing on all Graded Stakes Races.

RACHEL ALEXANDRA bobbled slightly at the break, settled comfortably outside, bid three wide midway on the far turn, took charge turning for home, responded to some left hand urging at the top of the lane, quickly drew off and was kept to the task. SUMMER BIRD raced close up inside, moved up past the half mile marker to challenge for the front, dueled inside around the turn, battled heads apart with MUNNINGS past the furlong marker and edged away to earn the place. MUNNINGS set the pace in the two path, battled between rivals on the far turn, dug in gamely in midstretch and then was outfinished for the place. PAPA CLEM raced close up between foes, then chased the pace, came three wide into the lane and rallied mildly outside. DUKE OF MISCHIEF saved ground racing off the pace and rallied mildly on the rail. ATOMIC RAIN raced three wide early on, continued off the rail and gave way. BUNKER HILL broke inward, raced four wide into the first turn, then chased three wide and faded.
