Footnotes

PEACE RULES taken off the inside through the early stages, set the early pace away from the rail, showed the way to the lane and widened then responded well and held SKY MESA safe through the closing stages. SKY MESA well placed early while saving ground, raced just off the inside and lodged a bid nearing the top of the lane then finished well while cutting into the winners margin through the final yards. FUNNY CIDE in close briefly early, raced between rivals into the far turn, was outside into the lane and offered a mild bid. WILD AND WICKED stalked early, lost some position into the far turn, lodged a bid outside on the final turn then weakened in the drive. MAX FOREVER in close briefly early, trailed while not far back, saved ground and lacked a rally. KOOL HUMOR broke inward some, raced outside throughout and lacked the needed response. EXCESSIVEPLEASURE stumbled at the start, stalked early from the outside, dropped back from between rivals turning for home and faded through the lane.
