DON SIX'S NUMBER tracked early, challenged for the lead on the turn and dueled through the lane then edged away late. DON'S PEACH set the pace inside, battled the top one then tired late while holding the place. BELIEVE IN DANCING advanced between rivals on the turn, raced in the three path into the lane and offered a gradual late gain. MAGGIESOTHERSISTER raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PINOT GRIGIO off the inside on the turn, was in the four path into the lane and lacked the needed bid. SOMEDAY ON SUNDAY up close early, saved ground into the turn, was just off the rail into the stretch and weakened. KNIGHT TRIPP raced just off the rail on the turn and offered little in the drive. STRATEGIC COMMAND stumbled at the start then lacked a rally.
