### Footnotes

BYE BYE BERNIE three wide into the turn, chased and reached the front passing the eighth pole then drew clear. DREAMSGONEWILD raced in the four path entering the stretch and finished steadily while clear for the place. BERT B DON trailed and four wide turning for home, offered a mild stretch response. PEPPERMINT PRINCE pressed the issue and weakened in the drive. HAVANADAYDREAM between foes into the turn, raced just off the inside into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. PRO PROSPECT set the pace, was along the inside rounding the turn and weakened in the drive. MUTINY pressed along the inside through the opening stages then raced in a bit tight leaving the chute and brushed the rail breaking stride and dropping back. The stewards posted the inquiry sign prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
