CLEARLY A QUEEN close up while saving ground, advanced nearing the far turn, challenged from between rivals a furlong out then finished determinedly while prevailing by a narrow margin. LAURICA stalked the early leader, lodged a bid on the final turn and battled through the stretch run then just missed. PRESUMED INNOCENT set the pace, saved ground and weakened late. CAUGHT OUT unhurried early, offered a late gain from the outside. SECRET RIVER well placed early, raced in the three path turning for home and lacked the needed response while between rivals at the wire. CONEY KITTY (IRE) headstrong early while in traffic, continued between rivals and lacked the needed stretch response. NOTABLE CRAFT never far back, raced along the rail into the stretch and loomed a threat then was not good enough. REMEDIATE saved ground turning for home and lacked a rally. CURIOUS TREASURES lacked a response.
