MARCHING TUNE up close early three wide, moved to the front on the final turn and drew clear then gradually widened through the lane, a driving winner. DIXIE BAND hung a bit wide early, advanced between rivals passing the quarter pole and finished willingly while second best. GAMBARU tracked early, chased on the final turn then needed more. ALKAZABITO saved ground to the lane, moved just off the rail entering the stretch and raced between rivals briefly then needed more. SILENT MONEY between rivals entering the far turn, was four wide into the lane and tired. SWEET BERNIE broke open his gate stall, raced off the inside into the first turn, was four wide passing the quarter pole and lacked a bid. MIPANDO set the early pace and tired through the lane. NAUGHTY AND BOLD was outrun.
