SALT WATER COWBOY advanced between rivals on the turn and vied for the lead then finished steadily while edging clear in the drive. SLAMMIN' SLEW advanced outside on the turn, raced three deep into the stretch and chased then earned the place. ISTANBULLY up close early inside, raced near the rail into the stretch, was angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly. LUCKYSDREAM set the early pace while being rated, saved ground on the turn and weakened in the drive. DEAL CASINO near the rail into the turn, was in the three path into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SAMMY'S TRIP raced four wide turning for home and lacked a rally. PARK SLOPE was asked for run on the turn, was four wide passing the quarter pole, raced in the five path into the lane and lacked a stretch response. FIGHT FOR LOVE saved ground and weakened on the turn.
