### Footnotes

RAGING DAOUST advanced outside on the turn, raced four wide passing the quarter pole, reached the pacesetter just inside the eighth pole and drove clear. CAPE COD CANAL set the pace just off the rail, showed the way into midstretch then weakened late while holding the place. STRASBOURG up close early and just off the rail into the turn, raced along the inside into the stretch then was gaining late and got the show at the wire. SPEEDING AGAIN moved inside nearing the turn, trailed and moved back out for the drive, advanced some then lacked the needed late response. BROOME STREET chased from the three path on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. ALUMNI bobbed at the start then jumped the temporary rail leaving the chute and unseated the rider. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning ALUMNI prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
