Footnotes

LATE STARTER set the early pace then lost the advantage on the backstretch, saved ground and regained the edge nearing the far turn, showed the way to the lane and widened under urging then was not seriously threatened. AVIE'S PEGASUS well placed while racing outside a rival, finished steadily and was second best. AWESOME'S ELEVEN reached the front on the backstretch, vied to the far turn, was three wide into the lane and drifted some passing the eighth pole then was best of the rest. RICKY TICK saved ground while well placed and lacked the needed bid. FOUR SHORE moved off the rail nearing the quarter pole, drifted out then in some in midstretch and lacked the needed response. OH SO DEBONAIRE trailed and had no rally. GAMBARU lacked a response then tired in the lane.
