### Footnotes

POINT GIVEN, fractious at gate, allowed to settle early, advanced outside approaching the half mile pole, was asked in earnest on the final turn, raced four wide into the lane and lugged in nearing the furlong marker, was straightened then finished steadily to prevail. TOUCH TONE drew clear on the clubhouse turn, saved ground while being rated, responded when asked and drew clear again into the stretch then held on gamely to the wire. BURNING ROMA well placed while saving ground, lodged a bid on the final turn, moved out slightly into the lane then finished gamely while between rivals through the late stages. THIS FLEET IS DUE raced outside turning for home and was going well at the end. JAMAICAN RUM saved ground and lacked the needed rally then was unsaddled on the clubhouse turn while in some distress and vanned off. HERO'S TRIBUTE vied for the early lead along the inside, eased out on the clubhouse turn, challenged again heading into the final bend then was steadied slightly when shut off in upper stretch and weakened.
