BANNER ELK LADY up close early inside, moved out into the lane and finished gamely to prevail. MAYDAY MARIA tracked early then prompted the issue, moved to the front in upper stretch then was outkicked by the top one. INTROVERT three wide early, moved inside on the clubhouse turn, saved ground while setting the pace then yielded in the drive. SWEETPRINCESSCHARM near the rail into the far turn, raced off the inside turning for home and lacked a stretch bid. ONE TOUGH WITCH four wide into the clubhouse turn, raced out in the strip down the backstretch and dropped back, continued away from the inside and lacked a bid while under some urging through the lane. TOUGH MARKET four wide on the backstretch, raced in the five path turning for home and tired. NICE STUFF five wide on the backstretch, moved inward and weakened on the final turn then faded late and was eased across the wire.
