Footnotes

AT THE DISCO drew clear early, set the pace inside and widened some on the final turn then responded well through the stretch run and maintained a safe margin. EVER A FRIEND well placed while saving ground, finished willingly while needing more late. GIMME CREDIT in a bit close nearing the end of the chute, saved ground to the lane, stayed inside and gradually gained late. SPORTING ART in good position and three wide into the far turn, raced in the four path entering the lane and lacked a solid late response. CENTRE ARENA (AUS) broke outward and steadied at the start, trailed while not far back, moved to the three path for the drive and lacked the needed rally. YORKTOWN (FR) near the inside into the far turn, raced between rivals entering the stretch while in the two path then lacked the needed late response. EXTRA ZIP tracked early, chased on the final turn and tired through the lane.
