WILBURN showed the early way then moved off the inside and tracked, challenged for the lead into the lane, was bumped and forced out passing the eighth pole, was bumped again soon thereafter, came in some then proved best to the wire. TEMPTED TO TAPIT reached the front on the clubhouse turn, set the pace and raced off the inside into the stretch, came out bumping with WILBURN twice during the stretch run then was outfinished by that rival. LINEBACKER trailed early and four wide turning for home, gained some late and earned the show. VALERIUS up close while saving ground, lacked the needed response. ENDYMION between rivals passing the half mile pole, chased and weakened in the drive. BEST ACTOR stumbled at the start, raced outside into the far turn and weakened. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the top two finishers in the stretch run prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
