CALL ME CARA up close and saving ground, tired. STRUMMING raced wide. C B CARM wide early, failed to threaten. BELIEVE IN PEACE was outrun. CLASSY RONI was done after a half mile. EXPENSIVE COFFEE chased the winner to the far turn and stopped.
