SWEET MISTY set the pace from the start and held on gamely in the final furlong. SHASHOBEGON settled just off the pace while four wide down the backstretch, commenced a bid in hand three wide on the far turn, swung four wide rallying into the stretch but could not gain on the winner while clearly best of the others. TOO TOO DIVINE stalked early and was a bit rank into the first turn, was close up to the pace three wide down the backside, was roused slightly off the rail on the turn and was an all out to hold for third. TASSO'S MAGIC ROO stalked along the rail, was roused on the final turn and ran evenly late. TIMELY BROAD broke a bit slow, showed no early speed and failed to be a serious factor late. BLOOMIN' DOUBLE stalked the pacesetter three wide early and retired on the final turn. CASANOVA MARKET chased along the rail and was no factor.
