GOLDEN MISSILE broke well, drifted three wide into the first turn, rated nicely while in hand during the backstretch run, made a run for the lead two wide on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch and was kept to task. SUPER MARFALOUS was the controlling speed early, was hooked by the winner on the last turn and gave way in the final furlong. TAPPAT outrun early, made a bid for the lead four wide on the last turn and ran evenly in the stretch. FRED BEAR CLAW was carried out four wide into the clubhouse turn, improved his position along the inside down the backside, was roused on the final turn, had no response. GULLIVER tracked two wide early, motivated to keep pace along the backstretch and weakened on the final turn. FAMILY CALLING was a brief factor.
