TRAVELATOR rated just off the pace inside, eased three wide making her move nearing the quarter pole, drifted to mid track in the upper stretch, dueled clear of Umpateedle leaving the eighth pole and held well with steady handling. CUPID SEASON was kept in range of the pacesetters in the four path, made her bid nearing the quarter pole, closed well for place however, too late to catch the winner. HIDDEN RANSOM rated back toward mid track, saved some ground going into the turn, was boxed in near the five sixteenths pole, angled out for the stretch run and finished evenly, widest. UMPATEEDLE rated with the pace in the three path, dueled with a short lead from the quarter pole then flattened stride the final sixteenth. LAVENDER LASS rated back inside, bid on the rail through the turn then leveled out the final furlong. WHOOP'S AH DAISY hesitated then lunged out, settled into stride toward mid track then passed some tiring rivals. SHE IS RAGING hustled to the lead taking up position just off the rail, set the pace to mid turn, remained a close factor to midstretch then weakened. CHIRIMOYA showed some good early speed outside then faded on the turn. FIT PERFORMER gave chase from the outside and gave way from the quarter pole.
