Footnotes

PLURACITY never far back and in the four path entering the lane, finished well while drawing clear. SUPER SHAPE (ARG) up close early, lost position on the turn, raced in the five path entering the stretch and earned the place. LONE CYPRESS raced six wide into the lane and was gaining late. CAME EAST prompted the early issue, raced three wide into the stretch and wakened late. JACOBY'S RUN up close while saving ground, stayed on the rail and reached the front in upper stretch then weakened in the drive. STARSHIP SCOTT set the pace near the rail and weakened in the drive. WHO'S THE COWBOY trailed early, came wide to the lane and offered a mild response. VINDICAT saved ground and lacked the needed bid. SMOKE'N REVIEW saved ground and lacked a response.
