Footnotes

AL MUHTASIB moved inward on the clubhouse turn and raced up close, was steadied when in tight between rivals entering the lane, eased out some and finished well while drawing clear late. CAPTAIN STONE tracked early just off the inside, moved to the front passing the quarter pole, responded to draw clear in the stretch then was no match late to the top one. MARINE MAJOR broke a bit awkwardly then moved up between foes to reach the front, set the pace inside and weakened in the drive. SEVIN was asked for run along the inside on the final turn, moved out nearing the lane and lacked a stretch response. JERSEY BROTHER near the inside, chased entering the far turn and lacked the needed response. PACHA broke a bit slowly and four wide early, raced well placed outside and lacked a bid when asked. NARBONA PASS trailed into the far turn and lacked a rally. SCAVEZZATO saved ground into the far turn and weakened.
