GASTRONOMICAL unhurried early, angled out upper stretch, rallied under right handed whip and was up in time. TAMPICO unhurried early, saved ground, swung wide upper stretch rallied and just failed. DANCE CLEAR saved ground, never far back, finished well in a dead heat for third with POOPSIE. The latter saved ground, rallied along the rail to finish on even terms with DANCE CLEAR. CHAMPAGNE ROYAL sprinted clear, was headed midstretch, in a good effort. SMART SHOPPER dueled between foes into the first turn, closeup throughout and outfinished late. TURKAPPEAL slow early, angled out fianl turn. B.A VALENTINE was forced out on the first turn. .
