CORONADO'S QUEST stalked ARCTIC SWEEP into the first turn and down the backstretch, made a run outside around the far turn to gain command, battled through the lane and proved best. VICTORY GALLOP unhurried early, steadily gained ground, rallied along the rail into deep stretch, was steadied twenty five yards before the finish. Jockey Stevens lodged a claim of foul against the winner, which was not allowed. GRAND SLAM never far back, made a run outside on the far turn to loom boldly but failed to sustain that bid. IAN'S THUNDER slow early, angled out with a mild bid but failed to threaten. TOMORROWS CAT raced in second flight and was never a factor. ARCTIC SWEEP sprinted to a short advantage, was headed upper stretch and gave way.
