EXCELLENT ERA lacked a rally. SPECIAL AMERICAN saved ground early, eased out slightly and lacked a bid. FAST RAPIDS was outrun. QUICK INTERVIEW just a bit fractious briefly in the gate, was angled over some early then showed little.
