CAVAMARIE saved ground while vying for the lead then finished well while drawing clear. LASTING LOOK dueled for the lead into midstretch then was no match while remaining clear for the place. MERRY MOOD raced outside into the lane and closed well late. SWEET FANTASY saved ground and lacked the needed late response. PETITE FANTASY between foes into the turn while in good position, was brushed during the stretch run and lacked the needed response. SUBSTITUTE WITNESS raced three deep while between foes into the turn, came in slightly during the stretch run and also lacked the needed response. SASS IT UP raced four deep into the turn, continued outside and had little left for the drive. HAY LO BLASE broke slowly and lacked a rally.
