GOOMADA BYDA SEA close up early along the inside, eased out nearing the quarter pole and raced three deep while between foes turning for home then finished well while drawing clear. GOTTA BE A STAR held a narrow advantage to the lane while just off the rail and was no match late while clear of the others. LIVE DOPPLER well placed from the outside, raced along the rail through the stretch and lacked the needed late response. ELUSIVE DREAM advanced outside soon after entering the far turn, raced four deep into the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. PLACE KICKER prompted the pace and weakened in the drive. MAGIC FLARE lacked a rally.
