GYPSY ROSE LEAH bumped at the start, raced off the rail rounding the turn and lacked a solid bid. TWILIGHT FANTASY vied for the early lead, raced outside and tired in the drive. SMART AS SCOT stayed outside and lacked a response. ALMOST A MEMORY broke outward and lacked a rally. MS. HUTTON raced outside throughout and lacked a bid. SOPHIA broke a bit slowly, saved ground and had little left entering the stretch.
