DECEPTIVE MOVE rated close off the rail, lacked room on the final turn, got through on the rail leaving the quarter pole, dueled clear than held well. EMILY P. rated back in the three path, bid on the final turn, closed on the rail through the stretch and finished well. PRIVY rated off the pace mid track, was widest entering the stretch, bid from there, closed well but was too late. SEA OF FIRE set a clear pace off the rail, was challenged leaving the quarter pole, dueled close inside to late stretch then relented the final furlong. BELLA FUMATORI kept up with the early pace about the four path, continued the chase through the final turn then leveled out in the drive. DR. PIPER broke out steadying slightly, showed no speed, saved some ground on the final turn then had no rally. MUNCHIES was outrun.
