Footnotes

ALL BETS OFF saved ground while well placed, moved out and lodged a three wide bid on the final turn, challenged for the lead turning for home and finished well while drawing clear. EAST TO EDEN forced wide into the clubhouse turn, settled close up outside, moved to the front nearing the quarter pole then was no match late to the top one while second best. LOVING ROE IS EASY had the left rein partially break heading into the clubhouse turn and went wide briefly, nearly lost the rider on the clubhouse turn, came again and vied for the lead, drew clear between calls on the final turn then weakened in the drive. BATTERY OPERATED raced four wide turning for home and lacked the needed rally. MY HONEY B in tight at the start, saved ground and lacked a bid. SUNDAY SHAPEUP came out at the start, vied early inside and weakened on the final turn.
