ASPIRING NICK outside rounding the clubhouse turn, moved up in the run down the backstretch, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and reached the front in the lane then edged away. TOOTS never far back, saved ground and finished gamely while clear for the place. R J'S PROSPECT trailed early, moved out for the drive and offered a late gain. GOLD CLOSE TO HOME saved ground early, raced off the inside turning for home and closed well late. EPIC EMPIRE saved ground early and just off the rail into the far turn, raced three wide into the lane and advanced then lacked the needed late response. GENTLE JOURNEY prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the backstretch and drew clear on the final turn then weakened in the drive. MAINE INGREDIENT lodged a bid on the final turn then weakened in the drive. CITIZEN BALLEY broke alertly and vied for the early lead, saved ground and tired

through the lane. JAZZIT raced near the rail while an early factor and tired. PICK OFF well placed early, raced outside and tired on the final turn. UNLIMITEDCASH was steadied in tight soon after the start then lacked a rally. GAMBLER'S RISK in a bit close early, chased to the far turn and weakened.
